Fairburn Engineering Ltd is committed to complying with accepted environmental practices, including the commitment to meet or exceed applicable legal and other requirements, to strive for continual improvement in our environmental management system, and to minimize the creation of wastes and pollution developing and promoting products and processes that reduce waste and environmental impacts through the adoption of environmentally responsible policies and practices in all Fairburn Engineering Ltd operations. Fairburn Engineering Ltd will follow the systems prescribed in ISO 14001

Fairburn Engineering's Environmental policy will be continually monitored and updated, particularly when changes in the scale and nature of our operations occur and signed by the Director of Safety. The Director of Safety will update the policy at least every 12 months assisted by the in-house Health and Safety Advisor

This policy will be communicated to all employees and contractors working for and on behalf of Fairburn Engineering Ltd and site visitors.

Parties interested in the performance of our environmental management system shall be made available; the general public, clients.

The following standards establish a framework for Fairburn Engineering Ltd to develop and implement policies and procedures appropriate to their business.

Standards

1. *FEL will achieve and maintain full compliance with all applicable environmental laws*

FEL will not knowingly violate any requirement imposed by environmental laws and will maintain procedures and systems to ensure or exceed compliance

2. *FEL will strive to operate in a manner that protects the environment and public health and uses natural resources efficiently.*

FEL will regularly assess the environmental impacts of their operations and endeavour to reduce those impacts at any stage of their operations where it is sensible to do so. FEL will establish specific objectives for reducing releases to land, air and water, waste generation and the consumption of energy and other resources.

3. *FEL will encourage suppliers and customers to develop and apply environmentally beneficial solutions*

FEL will liaise with suppliers and customers to find practical ways to minimise environmental impacts resulting from common concerns

4. *FEL will respond appropriately to expressions of employee or community concerns regarding the environmental impact of their operations*

In response to expressions of employee or community concern, FEL will endeavour to enhance understanding and awareness of the environmental issues related to their operations and to promote mutually satisfactory resolution of the concerns.

5. *FEL will manage its own environmental affairs and monitor and co – ordinate environmental improvement activities throughout FEL*

FEL will adopt an appropriate environmental policy statement and implement an environmental management system. Assessment of the company's objectives and the achievement of them will be carried out by trained FAIRBURN personnel. External agencies will be used for review and to provide specific advice as appropriate. Fairburn will use this information to strive for continual improvement of its activities
